




Celebrating the lifesaving potential of type O negative blood donors

Maximize your O Negative blood donations

All blood types have the power to save lives, but your O Negative red blood cells can be transfused to



any patient, no matter the patient's blood type. For this reason, it is used in emergencies, when there is no time to determine the victim's blood type. Only 7% of the population has O- blood, yet it is the blood type in the highest demand.

When you hear about car or motorcycle crashes on the news, there's a pretty good chance that our Universal Donors helped the victims. We often get calls to deliver more O Negative to the hospital when something has occurred.

Within the first four months of his life, Mack Hilzer had received 28 blood transfusions. Half of them were from CBCO donors – our O Negative, CMV Negative group known as Baby Quad Donors.

Mack wasn't able to make his own red blood cells due to Rh Disease. Mack's blood type is Rh-positive, while his mother's blood is RH-negative. With this combination, there is a risk of the mother's blood seeing the baby as foreign to her system and attacking the child. In Mack's situation, he was very ill and was delivered 13 weeks early at 2 lbs. 2 oz.

Things were touch-and-go for a while, with Mack receiving frequent transfusions. He has not had a transfusion since October 2015.
